DIVING

DIVE TRIPS

We are located in 18°25'07''N & 87°45'53''W. The diving trips we made are on the Meso-American Barrier Reef System, the largest barrier reef system in the Northern Hemisphere. This reef is more than 900 kilometers long, stretching from Contoy in the North to Honduras in the South.

The amazing section of the reef fringing the Costa Maya is typified by the finger formations, which create canyons and swim-troughs. There are two corridors of concentrated reef in Costa Maya. The first begins at the surface and is amazingly visible from the entire shoreline. This slopes down to around 50ft at around a 45° angle, and then plateaus. There is then a break in the reef. A sandy platform then separates the two corridors of reef. The second corridor starts off at around 50ft and stays level before a sloping wall begins. This wall slopes down at around a 45° angle, until the vertical drop off at around 165ft, which then plummets to an estimated 6600ft.

Typically in this area, there is a very slight current to the north, which makes for easy diving. Most dive sites are suitable for beginners and/or experienced divers. Visibility averages 75ft, and water temperature 26° F.

Common marine life found in the area includes turtles, lobsters, moray eels, king crabs, various stingrays, cat sharks, hammer head sharks, barracudas, dolphins, whale sharks (during their migration period), sail fish as well as most varieties of tropical Caribbean reef fish such as damsels, butterfly fish, pork fish, parrotfish and wrasses.

There are so many types of hard and soft corals, gorgonians, sponges. The reef itself is very healthy as diving in the area has been infrequent up to now. Fortunately, as tourism in the Costa Maya grows, the local government has shown its concern with the health of the environment, including the reef, and therefore encourages safe and environmentally safe diving practices. They have also focused on restricting fishing on the reef with nets to decrease the chance of damage.

HOW TO GET TO RIO HUACH

Road Map

Río Huach is located 400 Km. South of Cancun in the **Costa Maya** area. The detailed route is as follows: Exit Cancun, pass through Playa del Carmen, Tulum, Carrillo Puerto and 3 km. South of Limones town there's the detour to Majahual; 5 km. right before getting to the actual town of Majahual we take the detour heading South to Xcalak. Following that road on the 29 km. marker we take the path to the left until we reach the coastal line path, here, we make a right heading South and 10 km. when we reach the river we are at the North limit of The Río Huach Complex.
